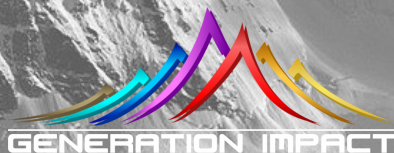

Water Baptism

The ordinance of baptism by total immersion in water is commanded in the Scriptures. All who repent of their sins and believe in Christ as Saviour and Lord are to be so baptised. This is a declaration to the world that they identify with Christ in his death and have been raised with Him in newness of life.

Accreditation

The current GIU curriculum has been accepted and accredited by Therapon University based in the British Virgin Isle. (www.theraponuniversity.org)

On graduation students may apply for Recognition for Prior Learning (RPL).

The university will issue the student with an internationally accredited Bachelor of Ministry degree.



Method of schooling

For believers who would like to grow in the knowledge and truth of God's Word, we have chosen to present the material as an online course with maximum flexibility. The course can be done at your convenience, at your own pace and you can start whenever you like.

Live lectures are offered weekly on a Monday evening and are recorded. The MP3 recording can be downloaded with the accompanying PDF notes. Study material is free when downloaded from the internet.

Students can, after completing the required examinable subjects, receive a Bachelor of Ministry degree.

The course is designed to be completed in 4 years. A year is called a cycle and students can start studying at any point during a cycle. It is important that the content/material for the course is completed and the examinations are done to receive the credits for the course/module. The order in which it is done is not critical.

Method of schooling

4 sections of training
equipping leaders
of tomorrow

1. Topics

Students have the choice of attending weekly lectures online or in classrooms when and where available.

Online lecture students must have internet to watch live streaming on Facebook every Monday night. Interaction with teachers or facilitators is provided on a Telegram group, allowing students the flexibility of attending classes remotely (home, business trip, holiday, etc.) or by gathering in small groups (church, support groups, farms, rural areas, etc.) where students can watch lectures together.

Using technology, lecturers can present their topics to the student body from any venue, whether a campus or a more remote location.

Monday evening live classes are presented as 3 sessions, each being on a different topic. 25 Topics are presented per term with a total of 100 topics per cycle or calendar year.

2. Bible Survey

The focus of the Bible Survey is that students read through the entire Bible in 4 years and answer simple questions on every chapter. In the term schedule the chapters that must be read every week are listed. This is spread evenly of the cycle or calendar year.

3. Assignments

Monthly assignments on various subjects must be completed in essay form and must have a minimum of 10 pages. 8 Assignments must be completed for year 1 through 3 and 9 assignments for year 4.

The assignment schedule requires 2 assignments to be completed per term to achieve the 8 assignments for the cycle.

4. Practical

Practical Hours come from the time spent by the student in the life of a local Church. This is done by attending services, helping in Children's church, youth, worship team, ushering, doing outreaches, feeding the poor, praying for the sick, etc.

Every student must spend on average no less than 2 hours per week involved in these activities. A record of these hours must be kept and signed off by the leadership of the local church and submitted to the school. A student must complete no less than 40 practical hours per cycle.

Examinations



On-line

Online testing allows you to keep track of your progress.

On registration students are given login details to access the GIBC testing platform.

Frequency

After every 5 Topics a test is written. For Bible Surveys an assessment is done after every survey.

Assignment are handed in and marked on completion.

Results

Results for online test (Topics and Surveys) are immediately available on completion. Marks for assignments are published when available.

Format

Exams are a combination of Multiple Choice, Mix and Match, and True and False questions. Students are allowed re-writes is required marks is not obtained

Credits

Surveys

On passing the exams/test for the Bible Surveys 1 credit will be given for each book of the Bible. There are 66 books in the Bible giving a total of 66 credits over the 4 cycles.

Practical

10 credits are given per cycle (1 per month) for practical work. A total of 40 credits will be accumulated for practical hours over the 4 cycles.

Topics

100 Topics are lectured a cycle. For every 5 topics an exam is written and if passed 2 credits are given. 40 credits are need per cycle and 160 to qualify for a degree.

Assignments

8 assignments must be completed per cycle, giving 32 assignments over the 4 cycles. Each passed assignment is given 3 credits with a total of 96 credits for a degree.

362 credits must be accumulated for a degree

Pre-requisites for enrolling

All Students need to have a personal email address. All correspondence will be emailed to the email provided.

Students need to have a studying knowledge of English.

Students should have access to the internet. Study notes, audio lectures (in MP3 format) and all exams are online.

Students need to be available for a Skype interview with GIU faculty should the leadership require it. This interview will be conducted by the GIU leadership.

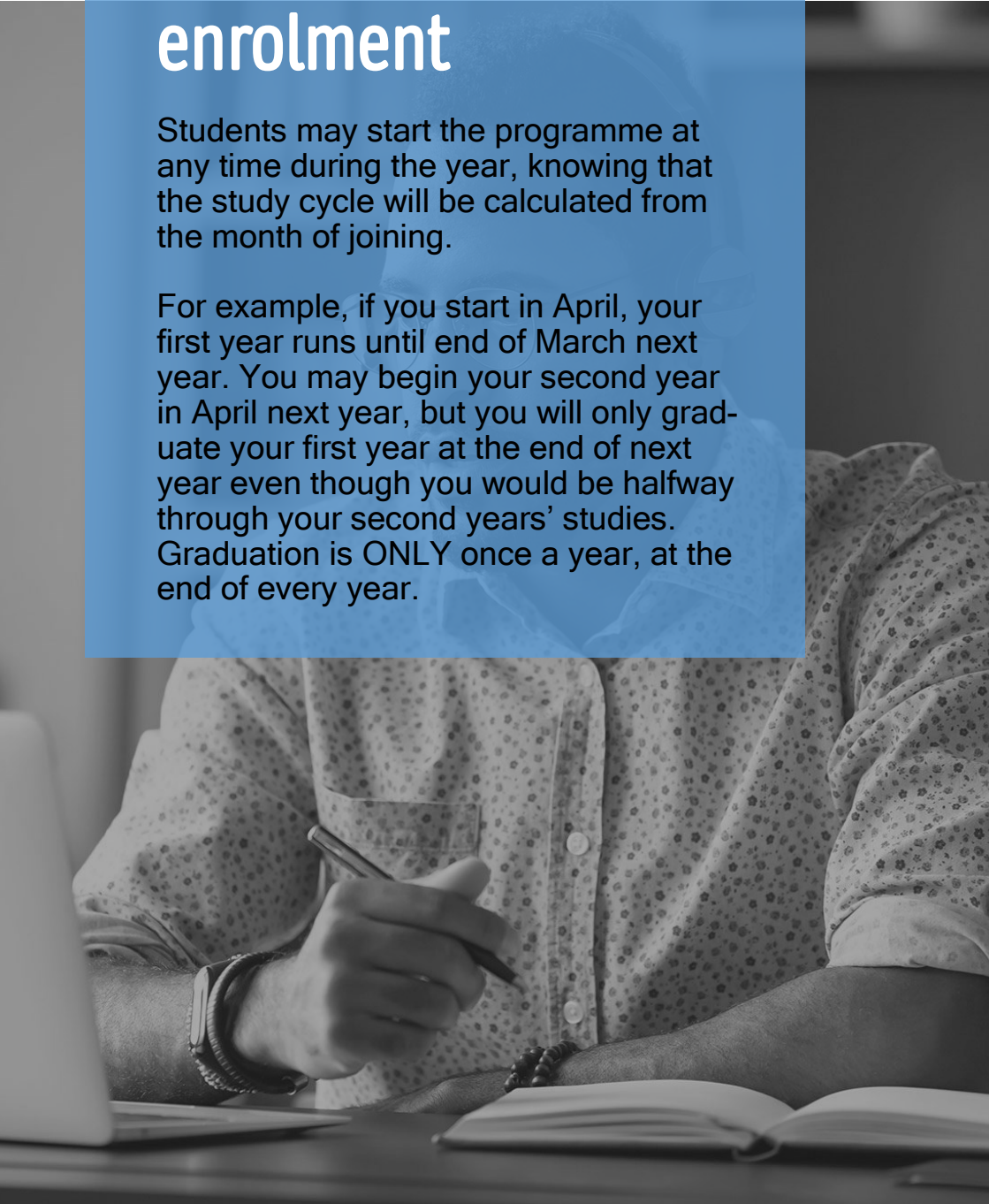

Procedure for enrolment

Students may start the programme at any time during the year, knowing that the study cycle will be calculated from the month of joining.

For example, if you start in April, your first year runs until end of March next year. You may begin your second year in April next year, but you will only graduate your first year at the end of next year even though you would be halfway through your second years' studies. Graduation is **ONLY** once a year, at the end of every year.


Using the PDF notes and Video or Audio recordings of the online lectures will prepare the student for exams.

Additional resources to broaden the students understanding of the Topics presented are made available on the Moodle platform where online exams are conducted.




